

Good wines, lots of food and friends from the ski club made for a great evening.
















DSC Tennis Tournament
















DALLAS SKI CLUB TREASURERS ANNUAL REPORT

During the fiscal year ended April 30, 2018, the Dallas Ski Club had total revenues of \$495,420.73.

While membership dues, activities, advertising and miscellaneous income contributed to revenue, the overwhelmingly bulk of income came from our Trips which generated 86% of the total revenue.

Expenses for the fiscal year were \$479,882.30 with approximately 94.5 % being spent on trips and other activities.

Publications and administrative costs were 5.5 % of total expenses.

Net assets for the club at the end of the fiscal year were \$172,865.47.


